# Termite Activity By: Rick Gardner

Drywood and Subterranean termite swarming season will end in the next few months. Drywood termite swarming season ends in late July to early August.

Subterranean termite swarming season can go to late summer. It is important to remember that even when swarming season is over, termites are still working and eating your house, 24 hours a day, all year long. Termite swarms are just a small fraction of the colony that are leaving to start their own colony. There is no house termites cannot get into, including block houses on a slab. ### From the Ground Up

Summertime has some distinct challenges concerning irrigation. Two weeks ago, we had 8 inches of rain and now it is dry. Whether turf or plant, variations in water cause distress in our landscapes. We cannot reiterate enough the importance of having a properly maintained irrigation system with a rain sensor on the system. We checked a home yesterday and the rain sensor had gone bad. One easy way of checking the sensor is to immerse it in a cup of water. The system should not turn on, if it still does, obviously the sensor is bad and will need to be replaced. This works both ways because sometimes a bad water sensor prevents the system from coming on when water is needed. We always recommend that our customers have a competent irrigation company perform a tune up and wet check at least twice yearly.

Tree injections on Sylvester, Canariensis, and Bismarck palms are always a hot topic. Lethal Bronzing is the new buzz word for the decline of select palms in the landscape. To drill or not to drill is the question. We currently service over 3,000 palms on our program and have had only one fall victim to this pathogen, even though it has been inoculated. We disclaim that this is a preventative program and not a warranty. Nature always prevails and nothing is guaranteed with her. The insect is a Lyndus that injects this pathogen in the tree and the injections are Oxytetracycline actually makes the leaf a bitter taste and the vector flies off to a better tasting buffet. On Bismarck palms, the borer is the insect that kills. It lays eggs in the heart and the little ones gleefully eat out the bud, causing death to the tree. We use a *Tree-age* chemistry that is a true insecticide that is systemic uptake and is a preventative treatment to ward off these bugs. We do notice that on affected trees that have just been pruned aggressively. A free natural way to inhibit borers is to selectively prune your trees. A pheromone that is a distress signal given off by the trees will attract borers from miles away to announce the buffet.
